1-1 Course Advising

July 11-12th - Music and Social Science Faculty One-to-one course advising is part of our Western Launch program. Students can meet with an advisor to ask questions about the coming year and get help with course registration and choosing first-year classes. Overnight Experience

OSAP is a financial aid program from the Government of Ontario that helps pay for college or university with grants and loans. It is open to all eligible Ontario residents. Accessible Education

Accessible Education is responsible for the determination and coordination of academic temporary and suspected disabilities. We honor in a choir? If so, they might consider auditioning disability as one of the many forms of diversity on our campus, and as such, we actively collaborate with faculty, staff, and students to support an accessible campus. Accessible Education provides academic accommodation for classes, exams, internships and other course or program activities, as well as digital and Braille textbooks, accessible campus transportation, learning strategy instruction for students with learning disabilities and more.
